You can savour the Green Hour through **30 nectars**, alone or with friends, thanks to the dedicated fountains. Philippe, the floor manager, huge absinthe-lover and -expert, spreads its wise suggestions, during the "spoon" ceremony.

**For each absinthe ordered between 5 and 7 pm, a "crock" will be offered.** Caroline's sardines rillettes, houmous, eggplants dip, tapenade, terrine or cottage cheese with black olives and marinated vegetables... A fresh and delicious homemade range accompanied by Jean-Luc Poujauran's crispy bread.
